Four pilot Apprenticeship HUBs started with their daily activities!

After the establishment of the HUB model and operation manual presented during the partners' meeting in Florence, this summer four pilot Apprenticeship HUBs in Croatia, Greece, Hungary and Italy started with their daily activities! Main task of Apprenticeship HUBs is to offer their services to VET providers, SMEs in agro-food sector and students. Responsible partners should focus on facilitating following activities: **providing information**, advice and guidance to young people; building capacity amongst training providers and engaging employers.

Apprenticeship HUBs will act on local level supporting the involved actors at transnational level, increasing opportunities for mobilities.

Through a web platform and social media, established hubs will provide following services:

- Awareness raising materials for companies;
- List of companies offering apprenticeship places;
- Matching services between offer and demand for apprenticeships;
- Toolkit for VET providers;
- Support services for the organization of transnational apprentices of VET students.
